We have specifically selected 6 members, including a veterinarian, that have experience in different positions of a Road Trial. This is to ensure that the Road Trial will run smoothly and allow others to develop skills in these areas. The 500-acre farm selected will meet the needs of both mounted and cart exhibitors. We have a local Stable that will provide suitable mounts and boarding for exhibitors. The Dalmatian Club of the Piedmont will underwrite the Road Trial with cash and borrowing equipment. Entry fees and donations will cover remaining portion of the budget.

Site Location

Double T Farms, 1163 Love Road, Pilot Mountain, NC 27041 has given permission to hold our Road Trial on their farm. The site consists of an est. 500-acre Cattle Ranch and joining woods. Pilot Mountain lies 15 miles north of King, NC. The site has easy access to Highway 52. The farm has rolling hills, beautiful views, three running creeks and a pond. Horses and four wheelers have ridden this site. The trail is suitable for mounted riders or carts and has several flat sites for the speed, distraction, and hocking exercises. There is a covered area at the beginning and the half way point of the trial. The covered building at the half way point will serve as an excellent site for the vet checks. An easy access is provided to this area. There is adequate parking for both spectators and exhibitors.

Rental Horses

The rental horses will be obtained from local Stables. The horses will be transported from Bucks Stables 1015 Moo-Cow Lane, King, NC 27021, 336-983-7350. The owner has agreed to provide suitable mounts for exhibitors requiring horses. Each horse will be groomed and tack will be available. The horses will rent for \$75 for the event. Buck Stables will provide board for those exhibitors that need it. The board will be \$8.00/day and include fescue hay, water and a fresh stall with shavings. Exhibitors agree to provide feed for personal mount and specialty hay. Exhibitors will be required to keep stalls clean daily. The Hosting Club will need to pay a wrangler for the price of \$125 for the duration of the Road Trial. The wrangler will be available for assistance and monitoring of rental horses. The wrangler will also provide assistance (companion rider) to novice riders on the course.

Judges Horses

Bucks Stables or Brylin Stables will provide horses for judge. The mount will be judged to be of excellent health and suitable for this event by Brylin Stables. Brylin Stables may

board Judge's mount for accessibility. There will not be a boarding fee for the judge's mount and a rental fee will be charged. Brylin Stables will work closely with the judge to make sure that the mount and judge are compatible.

Exhibitors Trailers

Trailers will be kept at Brylin Stables until event is complete except for those mounts that need to be transported to Buck Stables. Trailers will then be returned to Brylin Stables due to the limited space at Bucks Stables.

Date of Road Trial

Estimate date of Road Trial will be May, 4 2002.
