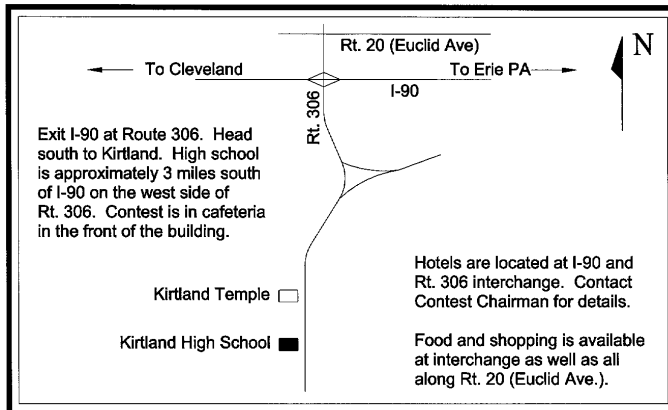
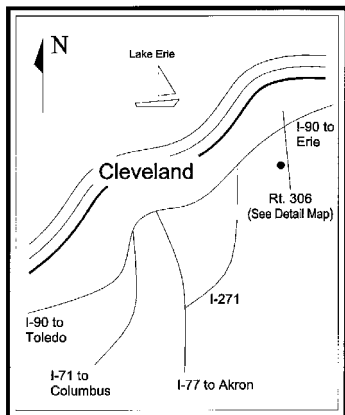
Contest Entry Fees: Adults - \$8 first 3, \$1 for each additional **Juniors and Bantams** - \$3 for Unlimited Entries

Contest Rules

1. The contest is open to all interested modelers.
2. **IPMS Regional or National winning models prior to 2006 or any prior CMS winning models** may not enter the competition *except for the "Ace of Aces" category*.
3. Entries will be judged on skill of construction, accuracy/realism and finish. A great amount of detail added WILL NOT make up for a poorly constructed model. Scratch built detail will be favored over commercially available detail if the quality is comparable.
4. All dust covers must be removed prior to judging.
5. Information supplied by the entrant describing techniques used in model construction is encouraged and can be placed with the entry as long as it is of reasonable size (index cards, photos, etc.). Reference material may not be placed with the entry. If an entrant believes that the realism or any other aspect of the model may be questioned, it is recommended that the entrant have reference material available for the judges.
6. If a model qualifies for more than one category the Registrars will decide in which category the model will be entered. In the event of questionable placement the Head Judge will make the final decision.
7. A **"DIORAMA"** entry must depict a story. A tank or plane on a base with a figure is not a diorama and will be placed in the appropriate armor or aircraft category. If, however, the tank or plane was being serviced or action is being depicted which tells a story, they will be placed in the diorama category. Under these rules those entries not in the diorama category will not have their figures or bases judged as part of the entry.
8. A **"CONVERSION"** must be a finished model that is a different variant/mark/model than the one provided by the kit manufacturer. A list of conversion details should be provided.
9. A **"SCRATCHBUILT"** entry can use parts from existing kits but these should be unrelated to their original purpose. Exceptions are wheels, gun barrels and tracks. A list of commercial parts used in construction should be provided.
10. The Head Judge can, at his discretion, split or combine categories prior to judging. "ALL SCALES" and other general categories may be split at show time, depending on turn out. Off scale models will be placed in nearest category.
11. SWEEPS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED. An entrant can receive only one award for each category in which he/she is entered. If an entrant has more than one model in the same category, the judges will determine which is the best entry and will use that entry for continued judging in that category.
12. First, Second and Third place plaques will be presented for each category.
13. The *IPMS John H. Glenn and Western Reserve Chapters* and *Kirtland High School* assume no liability for any lost or damaged property or any personal injury incurred during the course of this event.
14. **THE DECISIONS OF THE JUDGES ARE FINAL.**
