

Some Scriptural References Pointing To Our Covenant Through Christ

Romans 3:23-24

For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came **by Christ** Jesus.

Romans 8:1-2

Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are **in Christ** Jesus, because **through Christ** Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death.

Romans 12:4-5

Just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, so **in Christ** we who are many form one body, and each member belongs to all the others.

1 Corinthians 1:2-4

To the church of God in Corinth, to those sanctified **in Christ** Jesus and called to be holy, together with all those everywhere who call on the name of our Lord Jesus Christ--their Lord and ours: Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. I always thank God for you because of his grace given you **in Christ** Jesus.

1 Corinthians 1:30

It is because of him that you are **in Christ** Jesus, who has become for us wisdom from God--that is, our righteousness, holiness and redemption.

1 Corinthians 15:22-23

For as in Adam all die, so **in Christ** all will be made alive. But each in his own turn: Christ, the firstfruits; then, when he comes, those who belong to him.

2 Corinthians 1:20-22

For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" **in Christ**. And so **through him** the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God. Now it is God who makes both us and you stand firm **in Christ**. He anointed us, set his seal of ownership on us, and put his Spirit in our hearts as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come.

2 Corinthians 2:14-15

But thanks be to God, who always leads us in triumphal procession **in Christ** and through us spreads everywhere the fragrance of the knowledge of him. For we are to God the aroma of Christ among those who are being saved and those who are perishing.

Some Scriptural References Pointing To Our Covenant Through Christ

2 Corinthians 3:13-16

We are not like Moses, who would put a veil over his face to keep the Israelites from gazing at it while the radiance was fading away. But their minds were made dull, for to this day the same veil remains when the old covenant is read. It has not been removed, because only **in Christ** is it taken away. Even to this day when Moses is read, a veil covers their hearts. But whenever anyone turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away.

2 Corinthians 5:15-19

And he died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again. So from now on we regard no one from a worldly point of view. Though we once regarded Christ in this way, we do so no longer. Therefore, if anyone is **in Christ**, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come! All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself **through Christ** and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: that God was reconciling the world to himself **in Christ**, not counting men's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation.

Galatians 2:4-5

This matter arose because some false brothers had infiltrated our ranks to spy on the freedom we have **in Christ** Jesus and to make us slaves. We did not give in to them for a moment, so that the truth of the gospel might remain with you.

Galatians 3:26-29

You are all sons of God through faith **in Christ** Jesus, for all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. There is neither Jew nor Greek, slave nor free, male nor female, for you are all one **in Christ** Jesus. If you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

Galatians 5:4-6

You who are trying to be justified by law have been alienated from Christ; you have fallen away from grace. But by faith we eagerly await through the Spirit the righteousness for which we hope. For **in Christ** Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision has any value. The only thing that counts is faith expressing itself through love.

Galatians 6:14-15

May I never boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, **through which** the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. Neither circumcision nor uncircumcision means anything; what counts is a new creation.

Some Scriptural References Pointing To Our Covenant Through Christ

Ephesians 1:3-11

vs 3: Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing **in Christ**.

vs 4: For he chose us **in Him** before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight.
In love

vs 5: he predestined us to be adopted as his sons **through Jesus Christ**, in accordance with his pleasure and will--

vs 6: to the praise of his glorious grace, which he has freely given us in the One he loves.

vs 7: **In Him** we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace

vs 8: that he lavished on us with all wisdom and understanding.

vs 9: And he made known to us the mystery of his will according to his good pleasure, which he purposed **in Christ**,

vs 10: to be put into effect when the times will have reached their fulfillment--to bring all things in heaven and on earth together under one head, even Christ.

vs 11: **In Him** we were also chosen, having been predestined according to the plan of him who works out everything in conformity with the purpose of his will,

vs 12: in order that we, who were the first to hope **in Christ**, might be for the praise of his glory.

Ephesians 1:18-23

vs 18: I pray also that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints,

vs 19: and his incomparably great power for us who believe. That power is like the working of his mighty strength,

vs 20: which he exerted **in Christ** when he raised him from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly realms,

vs 21: far above all rule and authority, power and dominion, and every title that can be given, not only in the present age but also in the one to come.

vs 22: And God placed all things under his feet and appointed him to be head over everything for the church,

vs 23: which is his body, the fullness of him who fills everything in every way.

Ephesians 2:6-13

vs 6: And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms **in Christ** Jesus,

vs 7: in order that in the coming ages he might show the incomparable riches of his grace, expressed in his kindness to us **in Christ** Jesus.

vs 8: For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith--and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God--

vs 9: not by works, so that no one can boast.

vs 10: For we are God's workmanship, created **in Christ** Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

vs 11: Therefore, remember that formerly you who are Gentiles by birth and called "uncircumcised" by those who call themselves "the circumcision" (that done in the body by the hands of men)--

vs 12: remember that at that time you were separate from Christ, excluded from citizenship in Israel and foreigners to the covenants of the promise, without hope and without God in the world.

vs 13: But now **in Christ** Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near through the blood of Christ.

Ephesians 3:4-6

In reading this, then, you will be able to understand my insight into the mystery of Christ, which was not made known to men in other generations as it has now been revealed by the Spirit to God's holy apostles and prophets. This mystery is that through the gospel the Gentiles are heirs together with Israel, members together of one body, and sharers together in the promise **in Christ** Jesus.

Philippians 3:13-14

Brothers, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward **in Christ** Jesus.

Colossians 1:27-28

To them God has chosen to make known among the Gentiles the glorious riches of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory. We proclaim him, admonishing and teaching everyone with all wisdom, so that we may present everyone perfect **in Christ**.

Some Scriptural References Pointing To Our Covenant Through Christ

1 Thessalonians 4:15-17

According to the Lord's own word, we tell you that we who are still alive, who are left till the coming of the Lord, will certainly not precede those who have fallen asleep. For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead **in Christ** will rise first. After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever.

1 Thessalonians 5:12-18

Now we ask you, brothers, to respect those who work hard among you, who are over you in the Lord and who admonish you. Hold them in the highest regard in love because of their work. Live in peace with each other. And we urge you, brothers, warn those who are idle, encourage the timid, help the weak, be patient with everyone. Make sure that nobody pays back wrong for wrong, but always try to be kind to each other and to everyone else. Be joyful always; pray continually; give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you **in Christ** Jesus.

1 Timothy 1:13-14

Even though I was once a blasphemer and a persecutor and a violent man, I was shown mercy because I acted in ignorance and unbelief. The grace of our Lord was poured out on me abundantly, along with the faith and love that are **in Christ** Jesus.

2 Timothy 1:9-14

Who has saved us and called us to a holy life--not because of anything we have done but because of his own purpose and grace. This grace was given us **in Christ** Jesus before the beginning of time, but it has now been revealed through the appearing of our Savior, Christ Jesus, who has destroyed death and has brought life and immortality to light through the gospel. And of this gospel I was appointed a herald and an apostle and a teacher. That is why I am suffering as I am. Yet I am not ashamed, because I know whom I have believed, and am convinced that he is able to guard what I have entrusted to him for that day. What you heard from me, keep as the pattern of sound teaching, with faith and love **in Christ** Jesus. Guard the good deposit that was entrusted to you--guard it with the help of the Holy Spirit who lives in us. You then, my son, be strong in the grace that is **in Christ** Jesus.

2 Timothy 2:10-13

Therefore I endure everything for the sake of the elect, that they too may obtain the salvation that is **in Christ** Jesus, with eternal glory. Here is a trustworthy saying: If we died with him, we will also live with him; if we endure, we will also reign with him. If we disown him, he will also disown us; if we are faithless, he will remain faithful, for he cannot disown himself.

Some Scriptural References Pointing To Our Covenant Through Christ

2 Timothy 3:14-17

But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of, because you know those from whom you learned it, and how from infancy you have known the holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith **in Christ** Jesus. All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

Philemon 1:4-6

I always thank my God as I remember you in my prayers, because I hear about your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all the saints. I pray that you may be active in sharing your faith, so that you will have a full understanding of every good thing we have **in Christ**.

2 Peter 1:5-8

For this very reason, make every effort to add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; and to godliness, brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness, love. For if you possess these qualities in increasing measure, they will keep you from being ineffective and **unproductive in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ**.

2 John 1:8-9

Watch out that you do not lose what you have worked for, but that you may be rewarded fully. Anyone who runs ahead and does not continue in the teaching of Christ does not have God; whoever continues in the teaching has both the Father and the Son.

Acts 17:27-28

God did this so that men would seek him and perhaps reach out for him and find him, though he is not far from each one of us. 'For **in Him** we live and move and have our being.' As some of your own poets have said, 'We are his offspring.'

John 1:3-5

Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. **In Him** was life, and that life was the light of men. The light shines in the darkness, but the darkness has not understood it.

John 3:14-18

Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the desert, so the Son of Man must be lifted up, that everyone who believes **in Him** may have eternal life. "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only son, that whoever believes **in Him** shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world **through him**. Whoever believes **in Him** is

not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son.

2 Corinthians 5:21

God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that **in Him** we might become the righteousness of God.

Philippians 3:8-9

What is more, I consider everything a loss compared to the surpassing greatness of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things. I consider them rubbish, that I may **gain Christ** and be found **in Him**, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which is through faith **in Christ**--the righteousness that comes from God and is by faith.

Colossians 2:5-10

For though I am absent from you in body, I am present with you in spirit and delight to see how orderly you are and how firm your faith **in Christ** is. So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live **in Him**, rooted and built up **in Him**, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness. See to it that no one takes you captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the basic principles of this world rather than on Christ. For **in Christ** all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form, and you have been given fullness **in Christ**, who is the head over every power and authority.

1 John 2:4-9

The man who says, "I know him," but does not do what he commands is a liar, and the truth is not **in Him**. But if anyone obeys his word, God's love is truly made complete **in Him**. This is how we know we are **in Him**: Whoever claims to live **in Him** must walk as Jesus did. Dear friends, I am not writing you a new command but an old one, which you have had since the beginning. This old command is the message you have heard. Yet I am writing you a new command; its truth is seen **in Him** and you, because the darkness is passing and the true light is already shining. Anyone who claims to be in the light but hates his brother is still in the darkness.

1 John 2:27-29

As for you, the anointing you received from him remains in you, and you do not need anyone to teach you. But as his anointing teaches you about all things and as that anointing is real, not counterfeit--just as it has taught you, remain **in Him**. And now, dear children, continue **in Him**, so that when he appears we may be confident and unashamed before him at his coming. If you know that he is righteous, you know that everyone who does what is right has been born of him.

1 John 3:2-6

Dear friends, now we are children of God, and what we will be has not yet been made known. But we know that when he appears, we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is. Everyone who has

this hope **in Him** purifies himself, just as he is pure. Everyone who sins breaks the law; in fact, sin is lawlessness. But you know that he appeared so that he might take away our sins. And **in Him** is no sin. No one who lives **in Him** keeps on sinning. No one who continues to sin has either seen him or known him.

1 John 3:23-24

And this is his command: to believe in the name of his Son, Jesus Christ, and to love one another as he commanded us. Those who obey his commands live **in Him**, and he in them. And this is how we know that he lives in us: We know it by the Spirit he gave us.

1 John 4:13-17

We know that we live **in Him** and he in us, because he has given us of his Spirit. And we have seen and testify that the Father has sent his Son to be the Savior of the world. If anyone acknowledges that Jesus is the Son of God, God lives **in Him** and he in God. And so we know and rely on the love God has for us. God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God **in Him**. In this way, love is made complete among us so that we will have confidence on the day of judgment, because in this world we are like him.

1 John 5:13-20

I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life. This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that he hears us--whatever we ask--we know that we have what we asked of him. We know that anyone born of God does not continue to sin; the one who was born of God keeps him safe, and the evil one cannot harm him. We know that we are children of God, and that the whole world is under the control of the evil one. We know also that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding, so that we may know him who is true. And we are **in Him** who is true--even in his Son Jesus Christ. He is the true God and eternal life.

Ephesians 5:8-10

For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Live as children of light (for the fruit of the light consists in all goodness, righteousness and truth) and find out what pleases the Lord.

Ephesians 6:10-11

Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on the full armor of God so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes.

Ephesians 2:19-22

Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and aliens, but fellow citizens with God's people and members of God's household, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ

Some Scriptural References Pointing To Our Covenant Through Christ

Jesus himself as the chief cornerstone. **In Him** the whole building is joined together and rises to become a holy temple in the Lord. And **in Him** you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit.

Ephesians 3:10-12

His intent was that now, through the church, the manifold wisdom of God should be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly realms, according to his eternal purpose which he accomplished **in Christ** Jesus our Lord. **In Him** and through faith **in Him** we may approach God with freedom and confidence.

Colossians 1:13-18

vs 13: For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves,

vs 14: in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

vs 15: He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation.

vs 16: For by him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things were created by him and for him.

vs 17: He is before all things, and **in Him** all things hold together.

vs 18: And he is the head of the body, the church; he is the beginning and the firstborn from among the dead, so that in everything he might have the supremacy.

Colossians 2:2-3

My purpose is that they may be encouraged in heart and united in love, so that they may have the full riches of complete understanding, in order that they may know the mystery of God, namely, Christ, in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

Colossians 2:11-14

In Him you were also circumcised, in the putting off of the sinful nature, not with a circumcision done by the hands of men but with the circumcision done **by Christ**, having been buried with him in baptism and raised with him through your faith in the power of God, who raised him from the dead. When you were dead in your sins and in the uncircumcision of your sinful nature, God made you alive with Christ. He forgave us all our sins, having canceled the written code, with its regulations, that was against us and that stood opposed to us; he took it away, nailing it to the cross.

Some Scriptural References Pointing To Our Covenant Through Christ

1 Peter 1:8

Though you have not seen him, you love him; and even though you do not see him now, you believe **in Him** and are filled with an inexpressible and glorious joy, for you are receiving the goal of your faith, the salvation of your souls.

Romans 3:22

This righteousness from God comes through faith **in Jesus** Christ to all who believe. There is no difference, for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came **by Christ** Jesus.

Romans 5:15

But the gift is not like the trespass. For if the many died by the trespass of the one man, how much more did God's grace and the gift that came by the grace of the one man, Jesus Christ, overflow to the many! (also Romans 5:16-17)

Romans 7:4

So, my brothers, you also died to the law through the body of Christ, that you might belong to another, to him who was raised from the dead, in order that we might bear fruit to God.

1 Corinthians 1:4-9

I always thank God for you because of his grace given you **in Christ** Jesus. For **in Him** you have been enriched in every way--in all your speaking and in all your knowledge--because our testimony about Christ was confirmed in you. Therefore you do not lack any spiritual gift as you eagerly wait for our Lord Jesus Christ to be revealed. He will keep you strong to the end, so that you will be blameless on the day of our Lord Jesus Christ. God, who has called you into fellowship with his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, is faithful.

Galatians 2:16

Know that a man is not justified by observing the law, but by faith **in Jesus** Christ. So we, too, have put our faith **in Christ** Jesus that we may be justified by faith **in Christ** and not by observing the law, because by observing the law no one will be justified.

Philippians 1:11

Filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes **through Jesus** Christ--to the glory and praise of God.

Philippians 4:19

And my God will meet all your needs according to his glorious riches **in Christ** Jesus.

Some Scriptural References Pointing To Our Covenant Through Christ

1 Peter 2:4-5

As you come to him, the living Stone--rejected by men but chosen by God and precious to him--you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God **through Jesus** Christ.

1 Peter 5:8-10

Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. Resist him, standing firm in the faith, because you know that your brothers throughout the world are undergoing the same kind of sufferings. And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory **in Christ**, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast.

1 Corinthians 8:6

Yet for us there is but one God, the Father, **from whom** all things came and for whom we live; and there is but one Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom all things came and through whom we live.

Colossians 1:20-23

And **through him** to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross. Once you were alienated from God and were enemies in your minds because of your evil behavior. But now he has reconciled you **by Christ's** physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation--if you continue in your faith, established and firm, not moved from the hope held out in the gospel. This is the gospel that you heard and that has been proclaimed to every creature under heaven, and of which I, Paul, have become a servant.

Colossians 3:15-17

Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful. Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom, and as you sing psalms, hymns and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God. And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father **through him**.

Hebrews 7:24-25

But because Jesus lives forever, he has a permanent priesthood. Therefore he is able to save completely those who come to God **through him**, because he always lives to intercede for them.

Hebrews 13:14-15

For here we do not have an enduring city, but we are looking for the city that is to come. **Through Jesus**, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise--the fruit of lips that confess

his name.

1 Peter 1:21-25

vs 21: **Through him** you believe in God, who raised him from the dead and glorified him, and so your faith and hope are in God.

vs 22: Now that you have purified yourselves by obeying the truth so that you have sincere love for your brothers, love one another deeply, from the heart.

vs 23: For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God.

vs 24: For, "All men are like grass, and all their glory is like the flowers of the field; the grass withers and the flowers fall,

vs 25: but the word of the Lord stands forever." And this is the word that was preached to you.

Hebrews 1:1-3

In the past God spoke to our forefathers through the prophets at many times and in various ways, but in these last days he has spoken to us **by his Son**, whom he appointed heir of all things, and **through whom** he made the universe. The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word. After he had provided purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty in heaven.

Hebrews 9:11-15

When Christ came as high priest of the good things that are already here, he went through the greater and more perfect tabernacle that is not man-made, that is to say, not a part of this creation. He did not enter by means of the blood of goats and calves; but he entered the Most Holy Place once for all by his own blood, having obtained eternal redemption. The blood of goats and bulls and the ashes of a heifer sprinkled on those who are ceremonially unclean sanctify them so that they are outwardly clean. How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God! For this reason Christ is the mediator of a new covenant, that those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance--now that he has died as a ransom to set them free from the sins committed under the first covenant.

Hebrews 10:19-25

vs 19: Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the **blood of Jesus**,

vs 20: by a new and living way opened for us through the curtain, that is, his body,

vs 21: and since we have a great priest over the house of God,

vs 22: let us draw near to God with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water.

vs 23: Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful.

vs 24: And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds.

vs 25: Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another--and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

Romans 5:1-2

Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God **through our Lord Jesus Christ**, through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. And we rejoice in the hope of the glory of God.

Ephesians 4:15-16

Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will in all things grow up **into him** who is the Head, that is, Christ. From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work.

Colossians 2:19-20

He has lost connection with the Head, from whom the whole body, supported and held together by its ligaments and sinews, grows as God causes it to grow. Since you died **with Christ** to the basic principles of this world, why, as though you still belonged to it, do you submit to its rules:

2 Corinthians 2:15-17

For we are to God the aroma of Christ among those who are being saved and those who are perishing. Therefore do not let anyone judge you by what you eat or drink, or with regard to a religious festival, a New Moon celebration or a Sabbath day. These are a shadow of the things that were to come; the reality, however, is found **in Christ**.

Colossians 3:23-24

Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working **for the Lord**, not for men, since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving.

1 John 1:5-7

This is the message we have heard from him and declare to you: God is light; **in Him** there is no darkness at all. If we claim to have fellowship with him yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not

live by the truth. If we claim to have fellowship with him yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not live by the truth. But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.

Romans 5:11

Not only is this so, but we also rejoice in God **through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom** we have now received reconciliation.

Romans 6:22-23

But now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves to God, the benefit you reap leads to holiness, and the result is eternal life. For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life **in Christ** Jesus our Lord.

1 Corinthians 15:56-57

The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory **through our Lord Jesus Christ**. Therefore, my dear brothers, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain.

Galatians 3:13-14

Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree." He redeemed us in order that the blessing given to Abraham might come to the Gentiles **through Christ** Jesus, so that by faith we might receive the promise of the Spirit.

Galatians 4:7

So you are no longer a slave, but a son; and since you are a son, God has made you also an heir.

Philippians 4:6-7

Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds **in Christ** Jesus.

Philippians 4:13

I can do everything **through him** who gives me strength.

Hebrews 10:10

And by that will, we have been made holy **through the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ** once for all.

Some Scriptural References Pointing To Our Covenant Through Christ

Hebrews 13:20-21

May the God of peace, who through the blood of the eternal covenant brought back from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great Shepherd of the sheep, equip you with everything good for doing his will, and may he work in us what is pleasing to him, **through Jesus** Christ, to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen.

Romans 5:8-10

But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Since we have now been justified by his blood, how much more shall we be saved from God's wrath **through him!** For if, when we were God's enemies, we were reconciled to him through the death of his Son, how much more, having been reconciled, shall we be saved through his life!

Romans 8:37

No, in all these things we are more than conquerors **through him** who loved us.

1 John 4:8-9

Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love. This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live **through him.**

Galatians 2:20

I have been crucified **with Christ** and I no longer live, but **Christ lives in me.** The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

Ephesians 2:5

Made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions--it is by grace you have been saved. And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms **in Christ** Jesus, in order that in the coming ages he might show the incomparable riches of his grace, expressed in his kindness to us **in Christ** Jesus.

Colossians 3:1-3

Since, then, you have been raised **with Christ**, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. For you died, and your life is now hidden **with Christ in God.**

Romans 6:4-7

We were therefore buried **with him** through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life. If we have been united with him like this in his death, we will certainly also be united **with him** in his resurrection.

Some Scriptural References Pointing To Our Covenant Through Christ

For we know that our old self was crucified **with him** so that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin--because anyone who has died has been freed from sin.

Romans 6:8-12

Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him. For we know that since Christ was raised from the dead, he cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over him. The death he died, he died to sin once for all; but the life he lives, he lives to God. In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God **in Christ** Jesus. Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its evil desires.

Romans 8:29-33

For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the likeness of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. And those he predestined, he also called; those he called, he also justified; those he justified, he also glorified. What, then, shall we say in response to this? If **God is for us**, who can be against us? He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all--how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things? Who will bring any charge against those whom God has chosen? It is God who justifies.

2 Corinthians 13:4-6

For to be sure, he was crucified in weakness, yet he lives by God's power. Likewise, we are weak **in Him**, yet by God's power we will live with him to serve you. Examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith; test yourselves. Do you not realize that Christ Jesus is in you--unless, of course, you fail the test? And I trust that you will discover that we have not failed the test.

Colossians 3:3-5

For you died, and your life is now hidden **with Christ in God**. When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory. Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry.

John 6:56-57

Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me, and I **in Him**. Just as the living Father sent me and I live because of the Father, so the one who feeds on me will live because of me.

John 14:6-15

vs 6: Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except **through me**."

vs 7: If you really knew me, you would know my Father as well. From now on, you do know him and have seen him."

vs 8: Philip said, "Lord, show us the Father and that will be enough for us."

Some Scriptural References Pointing To Our Covenant Through Christ

vs 9: Jesus answered: "Don't you know me, Philip, even after I have been among you such a long time? Anyone who has seen me has seen the Father. How can you say, 'Show us the Father'?"

vs 10: Don't you believe that I am in the Father, and that the Father is in me? The words I say to you are not just my own. Rather, it is the Father, living in me, who is doing his work.

vs 11: Believe me when I say that I am in the Father and the Father is in me; or at least believe on the evidence of the miracles themselves.

vs 12: I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in me will do what I have been doing. He will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father.

vs 13: And I will do whatever you ask **in my name**, so that the Son may bring glory to the Father.

vs 14: You may ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it.

vs 15: "If you love me, you will obey what I command.

John 14:19-21

Before long, the world will not see me anymore, but you will see me. **Because I live, you also will live.** On that day you will realize that I am in my Father, and you are in me, and I am in you. Whoever has my commands and obeys them, he is the one who loves me. He who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I too will love him and show myself to him.

John 15:6-11

If anyone does not **remain in me**, he is like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned. If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be given you. This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples. As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now remain in my love. If you obey my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have obeyed my Father's commands and remain in his love. I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete.

John 16:33

"I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world."

Matthew 18:19-20

"Again, I tell you that if two of you on earth agree about anything you ask for, it will be done for you by my Father in heaven. For where two or three come together **in my name**, there am I with them."

Mark 16:17

And these signs will accompany those who believe: **In my name** they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues;

John 16:23-24

In that day you will no longer ask me anything. I tell you the truth, my Father will give you whatever you ask **in my name**. Until now you have not asked for anything in my name. Ask and you will receive, and your joy will be complete.

1 Corinthians 6:9-11

Do you not know that the wicked will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived: Neither the sexually immoral nor idolaters nor adulterers nor male prostitutes nor homosexual offenders nor thieves nor the greedy nor drunkards nor slanderers nor swindlers will inherit the kingdom of God. And that is what some of you were. But you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified **in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ** and by the Spirit of our God.
