Pieced from Ellen’s Quilt, Chocolate Covered Cherries, and Elizabeth Roseberry Mitchell’s Graveyard Quilt, published by Halstead & Meadows Publishing.

A book signing will take place this evening.

Linda is known for bringing feeling to her historical nonfiction biographies of nineteenth-century women and their quilts. In addition to her work as a quilt historian, author, and lecturer, Linda is a professional violist, who works in the motion picture, television, and recording industries in the Los Angeles area.
