

# SALE OF DOG CONTRACT

## **PUPPIES:**

The puppies will have had a Health Check, current vaccination and a de-worming schedule that you will need to continue as recommended by your veterinarian.

The Breeder will furnish the Puppies Registration Paper and Health Record at the time of sale if available.

The puppy has been eating Puppy Chow Dog Food and it is not recommended to change the Puppies food for a one year period. If the Buyer would like to change the food it must be done gradually and not within the first couple of weeks after purchasing the Puppy.

## **Shipping:**

Shipping a puppy is very stressful for the puppy and puts the puppy at risk for coccidian, worms, and possibly kennel cough which is usually common in puppies that are shipped. These symptoms are usually caused by a bacteria and is brought on by the stress of being shipped. These symptoms are easily treatable and are usually detected by your veterinarian. So if you plan to have your puppy shipped please be aware of the additional treatment that may be incurred at your first veterinarian exam.

All of these symptoms are checked for by my licensed veterinarian before shipping, but may arise during shipping due to the stress.

## **GUARANTEE:**

This puppy is guaranteed against life threatening birth defects and hereditary diseases if the following conditions are met.

The buyer must take to puppy to the vet with 72 hours of purchase for a Health Check.

If the veterinarian finds a serious problem (life threatening) with the puppy the Buyer must notify the Breeder within 24 hours.

If the puppy dies within 72 hours, the Buyer must provide the breeder with a written statement from the veterinarian proving cause of death.

If the Buyer complies with these terms and a problem is found (that is from the breeding) or death occurs within 72 hours, the Breeder will either provide another puppy of the same value to the buyer (this could take up to a year) or return the Buyers money excluding the shipping charge.

Our puppies are sold as Pet Quality Puppies and we do not guarantee your puppies to be able to sire or whelp puppies. There is no way we can guarantee the color or size of a puppy now or as an adult.

The Breeder is not responsible for any expenses from the veterinarian including office call, exam, death certificate or any medications. If a problem arises with the puppy the Breeder must be notified before any action is taken or the contract is void.
